- 2. If unable to fulfill a credit you signed up for, it is your responsibility to provide adequate coverage.

- 4. Please report to your shift on time and check in with the Volunteer Coordinator. Credit is received after completion of entire shift. Shifts may be shared by adult members of the same family.

To complete your registration with the Bedford Barracudas Swim Team a deposit of \$250.00 (check only) <u>must</u> be received prior June 10. This deposit is collected in addition to family registration fee(s). Swimmers will not be eligible to participate in practices, until deposit is received.
